The Naturalization Process

The Naturalization process may have many steps but taken one at a time it can turn out to be a simple process. The package you send to immigration consists of information regarding your background. IRIS will help you to prepare this package and application. USCIS will then send you an interview date. At this interview you should be able to answer questions about your application in English, and answer the U.S. history and government questions in English. The interviewer will dictate a sentence to you, which you need to be able to understand and write in English. If you pass the interview, you will be scheduled for a hearing where a naturalization judge will ask you to take the Oath of Allegiance to the United States.
